CHARACTER	 With regard to my relationship with God: Who calls me into ministry? Who am I that I offer? How do I sustain myself over the long haul?
CONTEXT	 Thinking about where I serve God: What is my context and where is God at work? What does 'being church' look like in my context? What might I learn from cross-cultural mission agencies? How can I encourage 24/7 missional discipleship? How do I work appropriately and effectively ecumenically? How do I relate to people of other faiths?
COMPETENCY Communication	In relation to my public ministry: • How can I facilitate worship effectively? • How can I preach effectively? • How well am I understood when I speak and write?
